HAIR CARE

PROCEDURE FOR GIVING A SHAMPOO DURING TUB BATH/SHOWER BATH:

- 1. Gather necessary equipment.
- 2. Wash your hands.
- 3. Explain what you are going to do.
- 4. Provide privacy.
- 5. Adjust water temperature to 105° F.
- 6. Position client appropriately in tub or shower.
- 7. Ask client to hold folded washcloth over eyes.
- 8. Apply water to the hair until it is completely wet using nozzle or pitcher.
- 9. Apply a small amount of shampoo. Work up lather, massaging well with fingertips.
- 10. Rinse thoroughly, working from front to back.
- 11. Repeat washing and rinsing, if necessary.
- 12. Apply conditioner if desired. Rinse thoroughly.
- 13. Towel-dry the client's hair gently.
- 14. Encourage the client to comb his own hair to remove snarls and tangles, if able.
- 15. Apply rollers or set hair if this is to be done.
- 16. Dry hair with a hair dryer if desired.
- 17. If used, remove curlers when hair is dry. Comb or brush hair and arrange as client desires.
- 18. Make the client comfortable.
- 19. Remove, clean, and store equipment.
- 20. Wash your hands.
- 21. Record observations and report anything unusual to nurse/supervisor.
