My "Future" Story...in Digital PhotoStory3

<u>Assignment</u>: For this assignment, you will create your "Future" career story, basically what steps are needed to make you successful in the career of your choice. The story will begin the day of your high school graduation and continue for a minimum of 8 years. You may also include "life" items such as house, getting married, etc...in the story.

The narrative should begin like a fairy tale or children's book. "Once upon a time..." "In the land of Raytown, there lived a" or Dr. Suess, "'Today is my day! I'm off to great places, I'm off and away." (Oh The Places You Will Go)

- ightarrow The photo story should begin with your high school graduation and continue out a minimum of 8 years.
- \rightarrow You will narrate the story, There will be no words on the pictures (unless part of the picture)
- → There should be beginning and ending music
- → Minimum of 15 pictures but you may have more ©
- → The story should play as a movie using motion and transitions
- → Must have a title slide and a credits slide. Add an extra slide for Sources cited if you used any.
- \rightarrow Refer to the attached rubric for more details

This is your future! Make it what you want it to be (but be realistic;))

Sources of pictures may be:

- → Digital photographs
- \rightarrow Scanned photographs
- ightarrow Pictures, drawing, or clip art from online sources
 - SOURCES MUST BE CITED

Procedure:

- 1. Write an outline of the story you want to tell.
- 2. Fill the story in on the storyboard and then select pictures to go with the story.
- 3. Write out the dialog associated with each picture(s) with exact words. This will be the narration for your story.
- 4. Create the Photo Story
- 5. Check the rubric to make sure you have included all elements.
