Transitions and Edits	Smooth; appropriate to the subject matter and add to the flow of the video Story is moving at all times. Appears to be a movie. Confusing; overused; detract from the “flow” of the video Story stops several times and appears more as a PowerPoint

Narration	Narration is well rehearsed..Highly expressive, natural and engaging speaking voice. The pace fits the story line and helps the audience really “get in to” the story. Excellent pronunciation and grammar.	Narration is rehearsed. Uses expression. Speaks in a conversational style. Occasionally speaks too fast or slow. Pace is okay. Good pronunciation and grammar. Use of Technology for Presentation	Demonstrated a total understanding of how technology was used for the project. Applied new skills that were learned. Need assistance and applying new skills	Showed little understanding of how the technology was used for this project.
