Appearance:

Appropriate dress (neat and clean – no jeans or t-shirts)

Social Skills:

First impression
Firm handshake (at the beginning and end of the interview)
Introduction of self
Eye contact
Other general social expectations (such as thanking the interviewer for his/her time, how the applicant greeted the interviewer)

Presentation:

Sent/brought needed materials (examples include: copy of resume, application) Reasonably calm and relaxed Use of "light" conversation Balance of confidence and modesty Posture is straight and attentive

Questions Answered:

Pausing briefly to collect thoughts (but not an extended period of time) Pertinent and specific information Clear and brief, yet descriptive Accurate Shows knowledge of self

Questions Asked:

Prepared questions ahead of time to ask Pertinent and specific to the job Clear and brief Shows knowledge of the "company"

Conclusion:

Left clear image of interest in job Clarified next step
